General

Contractors are reminded that all spoil and other waste materials must be removed from the cemetery.

Interments

Please note that permission must be obtained at least seven days before an interment or addition of a monument, headstone, inscription, vase or tablet. **Permission must be obtained using the application form available from the Parish Clerk.**

Interments are restricted to:

- Parishoners of Awre
- Long-term parishoners whose permanent principal residence had been within the boundaries of Awre for a minimum of 5 years and who through no fault of their own:
 - had moved out of the parish to go to hospital or to live in a residential care establishment or nursing home,
 - or had moved into family care, on a permanent basis,
 - and who subsequently have died outside the parish.

Any deviation from this would only be in very exceptional circumstances, and would have to be discussed and agreed by the full parish council which normally meets on eleven occasions each year.

- Burial plots cannot be reserved.
- All burials will be undertaken in accordance with Institute of Cemetery and Crematoria Management policy.

Further Information.

- Headstones should be no wider than the plot and must not exceed 2'6" (762mm) in height.
- No grave furniture other than the 'memorials' listed below are allowed.
- Exclusive rights of burial must be obtained prior to installing any memorial.
- When exclusive rights have been obtained, the grantee is responsible for all future grave maintenance. The burial authority may, as part of its own ongoing maintenance commitments, need to contact the grantee in the future. It is, therefore, important that the Parish Clerk is notified of any change of address or transfer of responsibilities.
